More than 6,000 property owners in Contra Costa County have been notified that they are in a Priority Hazard Zone, and at risk for a wildland-urban interface fire that could destroy their homes. Homeowners frequently contact the local Fire District to get a list of contractors who can do the landscaping work required to reduce their risk.

In this one-day workshop, landscape contractors, landscape designers and related business owners will learn the defensible space standards set by the State Fire Marshal, and how to do the work to meet the standards in the various fire districts in Contra Costa County.

This two-part workshop includes 2 hours of classroom instruction, a group exercise and 3 hours of supervised, hands-on field-work or a design problem. The 2-hour morning session covers wildland fire basics, background and important features of the defensible space standards. Lunch will then be provided. After lunch, the group will break into work crews and design teams and transport themselves, their tools and equipment to a number of work or design sites selected by the Fire District. A qualified instructor will supervise each work crew in real world application of the standards to real property.
